



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS --- NCTA Board of Directors

The PCTGA holds one position on the NCTA Board of Directors. This position will be open to any interested individual commencing January 31, 2010. The position is a four-year term and will be voted upon by the PCTGA membership in January.

Any member in good standing of the PCTGA is eligible to be a candidate to be elected NCTA Director, providing the candidate has paid NCTA member dues by February 15 of the year in which the election is being held.

Those individuals interested in serving on the NCTA Board should submit a letter of interest and a one-page biographical sheet on their involvement with PCTGA and NCTA. This information should be sent to the PCTGA office, 4305 North Sixth Street, Suite A, Harrisburg, PA 17110. **All nominations are due in the PCTGA office no later than November 15, 2009.**

The responsibilities of an NCTA Board member include:

- Attend and participate in NCTA Board of Director meetings
 - Current term limit for directors is three four-year terms
 - At least two meetings are held per year
 - Each meeting usually lasts one and a half days
 - A small stipend from PCTGA is usually available to cover some costs
- Oversee the workings of two NCTA Committees
- Sit on the PCTGA Board of Directors
 - Three to four meetings per year
 - Each meeting lasts up to five hours
- Write a column for each PCTGA quarterly issue of *The Bulletin*
- Represent the position of Pennsylvania growers while at the same time working for the good of the overall industry as represented by NCTA
